Formed in 2016 through the merger of Staatsloterij and Lotto, Nederlandse Loterij strives to promote a healthy and active Netherlands. The organization combines the enjoyment of participants with social responsibility, channeling profits to eighteen charities, the Ministry of Finance, and NOC*NSF. Beneficiaries include well-known organizations like KWF Kankerbestrijding, TeamNL, and the Oranje Leeuwinnen.

Following the 2021 regulation of the online gaming market, Nederlandse Loterij expanded into sports betting and online casino games. Shortly thereafter, it introduced TOTO Casino and TOTO Sport, quickly becoming a leading player in the iGaming sector. Today, TOTO stands as the largest legal online casino provider in the Netherlands, continuously evolving and innovating in partnership with leading technology providers.

Alongside its market leadership comes a deep sense of responsibility. Nederlandse Loterij is dedicated to protecting players and raising awareness of the potential risks of online gaming. The organization prioritizes player safety, responsible gaming, and the combating fraud and criminal activity. Teams in Data Management and IT use real-time analytics, AI, and cutting-edge tools to gain insights into player behavior and intervene when patterns of concern arise.

The Head of Architecture leads a team of three architects and nine business analysts, with the analysts reporting to their own team lead. In this role, the Head of Architecture ensures that the IT landscape remains coherent, scalable, high-quality, and compliant. This includes overseeing new applications such as Player Account Management (PAM) and responsible gaming systems, guiding the technical development of a cross-sell channel across all lottery brands, and professionalizing data domains through Al and analytics. Innovations are applied strategically, with a focus on maximizing their contribution to Nederlandse Loterij's commercial outcomes and long-term strategic objectives.

Complex stakeholder environment

Nederlandse Loterij's IT organization comprises around 250 professionals. As part of the Technology Leadership Team, the Head of Architecture works closely with the Heads of DevOps Lotteries, DevOps iGaming, Data Management, and Infrastructure/Security, reporting directly to CTIO Maartje Geven. In this role, maintaining strong relationships with external partners and IT suppliers is essential, alongside the ability to steer a complex network of internal and external stakeholders.
