The company has built an incredible reputation for solid, lasting partnerships—still working with its first supplier from the fifties—as well as its technical and market expertise.

The strategic investment in Barentz by private equity firm Cinven in 2019 gave the company the platform and expertise to accelerate their global expansion. Since, Barentz has acquired more than a dozen distributors to deliver on its ambitious plans. The result is a fast and balanced growth trajectory of double-digit organic and acquisition-driven revenue growth, leading to a turnover of 2.5 billion euro in 2022. Human nutrition is Barentz' largest division and, together with the Animal Nutrition division, accounts for around forty percent of the company's business result.
